Answer: TRUE

Question 2: True or False: The fourth Vice-President of the United States was a man named George Clinton who died in office in 1812.

Answer: TRUE

Question 3: True or False: *Go forth and multiply* is a famous quote by Spock in *Star Trek*.

Answer: FALSE - It is a line from the Bible; *Live long and prosper* is the quote from Star Trek.

Question 4: True or False: The Fourth Estate is a term that commonly refers to the press or media.

Answer: TRUE - The first three estates are the clergy, the nobility and the commoners.

Question 5: True or False: *Twin Peaks* was cancelled after its fourth season.

Answer: FALSE - It was cancelled after its second season, in 1992.

Question 6: In the *Star Wars* anthology, what is the title of Episode IV?

Answer: *A New Hope* - *The Phantom Menace* was the fourth to be released, but it was technically Episode I.

Question 7: After July 4th, what is the next Federal Holiday of the year?

Answer: Labor Day

Question 8: What is the fourth-most populated country in North America?

Answer: Guatemala - The U.S.A., Mexico and Canada are 1,2 & 3.

Question 9: What was the fourth full-length film Pixar released? Hint: it came after *Toy Story 2*.

Answer: *Monsters Inc.*

Question 10: Which founding father has the honor of having both the first and the largest signature on the Declaration of Independence?

Answer: John Hancock - He was President of the Continental Congress at the time.
