Answer: A New Hope - The Phantom Menace was the fourth to be released, but it was technically Episode I.

Question 7: After July 4th, what is the next Federal Holiday of the year?

Answer: Labor Day

Question 8: What is the fourth-most populated country in North America?

Answer: Guatemala - The U.S.A., Mexico and Canada are 1,2 & 3.

Question 9: What was the fourth full-length film Pixar released? Hint: it came after *Toy Story* 2.

Answer: Monsters Inc.

Question 10: Which founding father has the honor of having both the first and the largest signature on the Declaration of Independence?

Answer: John Hancock - He was President of the Continental Congress at the time.
